

Kirdford Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan Review

The Neighbourhood Development Plan was completed in 2014. This Parish was one of the first in the country to get this important piece of work completed, submitted to the Planning Inspectorate, voted on and accepted by residents and Chichester District Council.

The Plan established a vision for the evolution and long-term sustainability of the Parish over fifteen years (until 2029) with a provision that it should be reviewed every five years.

So believe it or not we need to review our plan in 2019!!
