

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER  
Highways Act 1980

West Sussex County Council (Kirdford)  
Public Path (614/1) Diversion Order 2021

The above Order was made on 23 June 2021 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order will be to stop up part of public footpath no 614/1 in the parish of Kirdford commencing at point on bridleway 614 (GR 502478 124558) running south-west on the southern side of the boundary to Stroods Cottage garden for approximately 90 metres to GR 502395 124524 and then turning south for approximately 5 metres to enter a field. The path then runs south-west on a north-west headland for approximately 95 metres to point GR 502317 124473 as shown by the bold continuous line on the plan No. 01794.

A new length of public footpath with a width 2 metres will be created commencing at GR502317 124473 running west for approximately 10 metres, then turning north on a woodland track and continuing for approximately 154 metres to point GR502332 124626 on bridleway 614 approximately 164metres west of its present junction as shown by the bold broken line on the order plan No. 01794.

Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that any representations or objections to this Order will be kept on a file that is open to the public and while personal details will be omitted on request, they will become publicly available if and when the Order is sent to the Secretary of State.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the West Sussex County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER  
Highways Act 1980

West Sussex County Council (Kirdford)  
Public Path (No.614/1) Diversion Order 2021

This order is made by West Sussex County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 below, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr H G Hourihan of Stroods, Strood Green, Kirdford. RH14 0HL has agreed to contribute towards any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public and to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order.

The Chichester District Council, the South Downs National Park Authority and Natural England have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over land situate at Kirdford and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding anything in paragraph 1 of this Order, where immediately before the date on which a highway is stopped up in pursuance of this Order there is apparatus on, under or over that highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus they then had.
3. There shall be at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Kirdford described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map (plan 01794) contained in this Order.

Part 1

Description of site of existing path or way

Part of public footpath no 614/1 in the parish of Kirdford commencing at point **A** on bridleway 614 ( GR 502478 124558 ) running south-west on the southern side of the boundary to Stroods Cottage garden for approximately 90 metres to point **B** (GR 502395 124524 ) and then turning south for approximately 5 metres to enter a field. The path then runs south-west on a north-west headland for approximately 95 metres to point **C** (GR 502317 124473 ) as shown by the bold continuous line **A-B-C** on plan 01794

Part 2

Description of site of new path or way

A new length of public footpath with a width 2 metres commencing at point **C** (GR502317 124473 ) running west for approximately 10 metres, then turning north on a woodland track and continuing for approximately 154 metres to point **E** (GR502332 124626 ) on bridleway 614 approximately 164 metres west of its present junction as shown by the bold broken line **C-D-E** on plan 01794.
